About the Course

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who work as salon assistants and are competent in communicating in the workplace, interacting with and providing service to clients, and assistance to colleagues. They perform routine functions under direct supervision as part of a hairdressing team.

Pathways

After achieving SIH20111 Certificate II in Hairdressing, individuals may undertake SIH30111 Certificate III in Hairdressing or Certificate III in Make Up.

Prerequisite

There are no prerequisites for this qualification.

Uniform Requirements

Students must adhere to all WHS requirements whilst undertaking training and Structured Work Place Learning (SWL). This includes the wearing of long black pants and covered low heel black shoes. RTTC will provide a black short sleeve tunic as part of the course fee. A plain black cardigan may be worn during the cooler months.

Structured Work Place Learning (SWL)

Students who are funded under TGSS will be required to undertake 140 hours of SWL as part of their contract. This will be coordinated through home schools and should be conducted during term breaks or after school hours.

Non TGSS students will be encouraged to complete a minimum of 40 hours SWL.

Training Guarantee for SACE Students (TGSS)

This course is a TGSS approved course under Special Enrolment Conditions for 2019.

Students should check their eligibility and changes to the Skills for All funded training list.
