

About the Course

This course is the final stage in the Doorways 2 Construction Program and is designed to increase knowledge and skills in the field of carpentry.

Successful completion of this course will enhance the graduate's employment prospects as an apprentice or general employment in the building and construction industry.

The construction industry strongly affirms that training and assessment leading to recognition of skills must be undertaken in a real or very closely simulated workplace environment and this qualification requires all units of competency to be delivered in this context.

A substantial period of work placement is required to ensure that unit outcomes are met.

Prerequisites

Doorways 2 Construction Certificate I or II in Construction. CITB number.

Special Requirements

Students must adhere to all WHS requirements as directed by trainer. The approved RTTC trainee uniform and PPE will be required during all training and SWL.

Students must have good literacy and numeracy skills.

Students will be provided with the following through the RTTC at no additional cost:

- High visibility Jonsson work shirt
- Safety glasses
- High visibility work jumper

Additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to be purchased by student prior to commencement:

- Steel cap boots
- Beige work trouser

Fee for Service (FFS)

Students are required to undertake 100 hours of SWL to demonstrate employability skills.
