#### About the Course

This qualification provides an occupational outcome and a range of support tasks applicable to a majority of construction work sites.

This qualification has core units of competency that are required in many Certificate III qualifications. The elective options are structured to allow choice from a range of units aligned at Certificate III level.

The construction industry strongly affirms that training and assessment leading to recognition of skills must be undertaken in a real or very closely simulated workplace environment.

#### Prerequisites

There are no specific prerequisites for this qualification.

#### Special Requirements

Students must adhere to all WHS requirements as directed by trainer. The approved RTTC trainee uniform and PPE will be required during all training and SWL.

Students must have good literacy and numeracy skills, and will be required to undertake an LLN Assessment.

Students will be provided with the following through the RTTC at no additional cost:

- High visibility Jonsson work shirt
- Safety glasses
- High visibility work jumper

Additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to be purchased by student prior to commencement:

- Steel cap boots
- Beige work trouser

#### Structured Work Place Learning (SWL)

Students are required to undertake 140 hours of SWL as stipulated in the TGSS to be conducted during term breaks to minimise disruption.

#### Training Guarantee for SACE Students (TGSS)

This course is a TGSS approved course. Students must complete application form and have approval prior to commencing the course. The Resource Fee is not covered by TGSS. Non TGSS students will be charged a course fee until TGSS eligible.

#### Fee for Service (FFS)

Students who do not qualify for TGSS will be charged a FFS to cover tuition and resources.
