About the Course

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who work as salon assistants and are competent in communicating in the workplace, interacting with and providing service to clients, and assistance to colleagues. They perform routine functions under direct supervision as part of a beauty therapy team.

Pathways

After achieving SIB20110 Certificate II in Retail Make-Up & Skincare, individuals may undertake Certificate III in Beauty Services.

Prerequisite

There are no prerequisites for this qualification. However the Introductory Course will provide eligibility for TGSS. Students will be required to complete a LLN Assessment at the beginning of the course.

Uniform Requirements

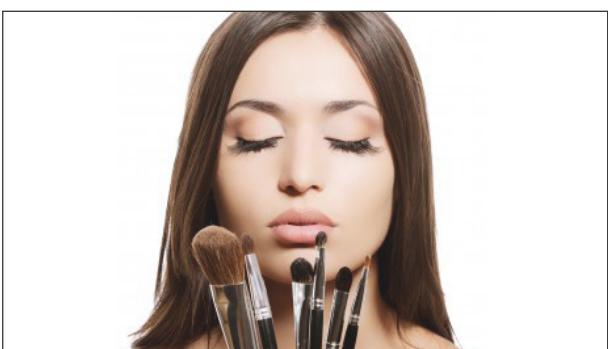
Students must adhere to all WHS requirements whilst undertaking training and Structured Work Place Learning (SWL). This includes the wearing of long black pants and covered low heel black shoes. RTTC will provide a black short sleeve tunic as part of the course fee. A plain black cardigan may be worn during the cooler months.

Structured Work Place Learning (SWL)

Students who are funded under TGSS will be required to undertake 140 hours of SWL as part of their contract. This will be coordinated through home schools and should be conducted during term breaks or after school hours. Forty hours of SWL is recommended.

Fee for Service (FFS)

This is a Fee For Service (FFS) course.
