NAPLAN

Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 have been undertaking the 4 NAPLAN (National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy) test papers. NAPLAN is made up of tests in the four areas of: reading, writing, language conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. It is important to not place too much emphasis on the NAPLN. It is the results of a few days only. The best indication of your child's progress comes from your child's teacher and the various assessment pieces done throughout the term.

SACE Merit Ceremonies

The SACE Merit Ceremony is usually held in February each year. This year it was postponed, then cancelled and then reinstated and split into 9 ceremonies over 2 days, Thursday and Friday of last week. It was great that our 2021 Year 12 outstanding

students were finally recognised in the SACE Merit Ceremonies at Government House.
Unfortunately it meant our large number of Merit winners couldn't all be at the same ceremony. Well done to all of our Merit award students at Mount Carmel College.

Ten percent (10%) of our Year 12 students achieved at least one Merit – quite an extraordinary figure, unmatched by most schools. To gain a Merit, a student must achieve a subject grade of A+ for that subject, and be selected by a panel, appointed by the SACE Board, as demonstrating exceptional achievement in the subject.

TRY-A-TRADE CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

One of the key signature programs of the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) is Dooways2Construction (D2C), an industry-supported secondary schools' program that provides career education and Flexible Industry Pathways (FIP) courses to attract students to a career in the Building and Construction Industry.

CITB has supported the delivery of programs within D2C for many years to provide students with exposure to various construction trades, especially those with low uptake of apprenticeships. CITB is now expanding their support for programs to assist students in making informed decisions about entering a D2C FIP course in building and construction and any other pathways supported by CITB by introducing Try-A-Trade Construction Program.

Western Technical College (WTC) is now offering students the opportunity to participate in a 5-day Try-A-Trade Construction Program covering the areas of Carpentry, Bricklaying, Tiling and Paving. In addition, the program will include learning and obtaining a White Card, all delivered by TAFE SA.

Try-A-Trade Construction Program is designed to:

- Assist students to achieve the VET Readiness (VETRO) requirements, by supplying a certificate of participation
- Introduce students' to career pathways in the Building and Construction Industry
- Enhance students learning and increase exposure to trade areas that students may be unfamiliar with and that have low uptake of apprentices
- Prepare students for entering a Building and Construction Flexible Industry pathways course such as the Certificate II in Construction Pathways
- Establish and encourage links between schools, students and Registered Training Organisations

- 4. Fill out the form

Please note, there is a student management
and Personal Protective Equipment fee of \$130.00

Special requirements: Students must adhere to
all safety requirements as directed by their lecturer.
The approved Personal Protective Equipment will be required during all training, including White Card. Students will need to purchase beige/black steel cap boots and beige work trousers before commencement at their own cost.


