A medical certificate is required if a student is away for more than 3 days. For any planned extended absence, a letter to the Principal is required to explain circumstances.




Moana Jr Musical - On Sale Now!

In our exciting unit Paws and Petals, Reception students investigated the fascinating world of living things by exploring two engaging topics: dogs and flowers. We learned about the important roles dogs play in our community—such as guide dogs, police dogs, farm dogs and beloved family pets—and discovered how flowers help our environment and the ecosystem. Through handson learning, observation, and discussion, students developed their understanding of how living things meet their needs and contribute to the world around them.

Each child became an author by creating their own information book to share what they had learned. We celebrated our learning with a special incursion, giving students the opportunity to meet and interact with a range of real animals—bringing the unit to life in the most memorable way!

Each child was thrilled to meet and interact with a range of living

Australian animals. Their eyes lit up with excitement as they gently touched owls, lizards, and observed marsupials up close, and even watched a sugar glider fly between teachers. Business Innovation: Mentoring Opportunity!



On Wednesday, 25 June 2025, the selected students accompanied me to the

Adelaide CBD, where they took part in workshops from 9.45am to 1.45pm. In preparation, each student developed a business pitch to present on the day, using the experience to inform their summative assessments.

As part of the Year 12 Business Innovation curriculum, nine students participated in a mentoring session hosted by mentors and faculty at the University of Adelaide. This session provided valuable feedback on their Business Model Canvas task. Throughout the session, students delivered their pitch to three different mentors, refining and enhancing their presentations with each round of feedback. They also had the opportunity to observe other students' pitches, fostering collaboration and meaningful discussion around their ideas and development processes.

This was an invaluable experience for the students involved. The insights and feedback gained will significantly strengthen their final assignments.
